



Welcome to the 37th Annual North Texas Council of Railroad Clubs Train show season.

Thank you everyone for continuing to support our train shows. This last year was extremely challenging for everyone but we were very happy to have had a glimpse of normalcy by holding a successful show in January and we couldn't have done it without great vendors.

For the 2021-2022 show season we are going to resume our normal schedule by having a two day show in the fall and another in January. The dates for the seventh annual Fall Plano Train Show are Oct. 2-3, 2021 at the Plano Event Center, 2000 E. Spring Creek Parkway, Plano, Texas. The Dallas Area Train Show is returning to the Plano Event Center January 15-16, 2022.

As of the end of April the NRCRC doesn't know what the rules regarding social distancing will be in the fall, but we are hopeful that with the current trend things will be nearly normal. We will take guidance from the Plano Event Center and the City of Plano as the show dates draw closer.

With ever increasing rental costs we are raising table prices by \$5 and electricity by \$10 this year.

Parking at the Plano Event Center is still free!

Setup times for the Fall Plano show are Friday Oct 1st from 10:00 AM – **9:00 PM** and Saturday from 7:00 – 10:00 AM. Setup times for the Dallas Area show are Friday January 14th from 10:00 AM – **9:00 PM** Saturday from 7:00 – 10:00 AM.

We will continue to have a couple of people assisting the direction of traffic in front of the roll-up door. Unloading is limited to **45 minutes**, so please be efficient so that the next vendor can back up to the door. This has been abused in the past with some people leaving their trailer or van in front of the door for over 2 hours. Please set up your booth **after** you have unloaded and not while you are unloading.
